Overview

Snowmaking is a rigorous, challenging job. As snowmaking is greatly dependent on weather, a snowmaker's day can go from very relaxing (in warm conditions) to very intense (in cold conditions). Snowmaking is a time sensitive activity responsive to the correct weather conditions and the deadlines of opening the resort. Snowmakers enjoy physical work, fresh air, incredible mountain vistas and team work that creates life long friendships.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Set up, shut down, direct, control, adjust and move the snow guns, hoses and appropriate equipment as required.
- Test the quality of snow as it is made, reporting findings and conditions to the Crew Leader
- Related maintenance work as requested
- Driving snowmobiles, trucks and ATVs as necessary
- Knowledge of and adherence to Occupational Health and Safety procedures as they pertain to your job function
- Follow communication protocols
- Use of two way radio system

Snowmakers have little contact with the general public. Although the contact is minimal, it is essential that snowmakers maintain a polite, mature and respectful composure when interacting with any guest of Nakiska.

Uniform: Snow pants and coat provided, must bring warm clothes for underneath uniform
