**Responsibilities:**

- Greet and answer visitors' questions, and assist them as required.
- Inform of, and enforce policies and procedures as outlined by the summer operation plan.
- Drive guests between the top of the lift and the Interpretation Centre.
- Assist with the whole operation as required.

**Requirements:**

- Must be friendly, outgoing, and enjoy meeting new people.
- Have the ability to listen, ask questions, and offer valuable knowledge to guests.
- Have the ability to maintain control of groups of all sizes.
- Must be eager to learn and show initiative to gain more knowledge of the area.
- Have some awareness of activities, environmental issues and events within the Bow Valley.
- A valid driver's license is a must.

- Experience working with tour groups, seniors' organisations, youth groups, summer camps, etc.
- First aid.
